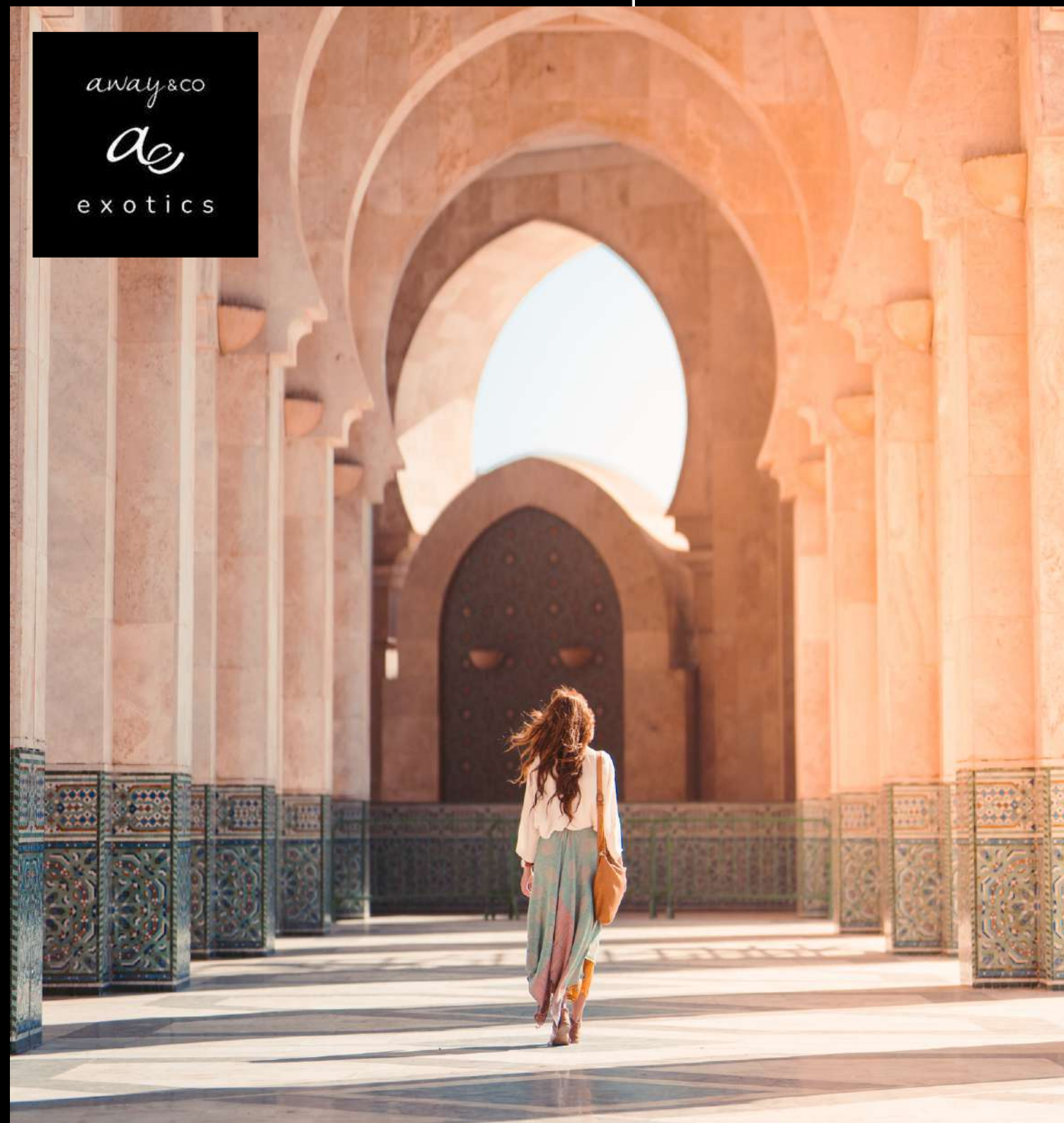

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DAY 01

Arrival in Casablanca

Upon arrival in Casablanca, you'll be welcomed by your local representatives before transferring to your hotel. This evening, begin your Moroccan journey with a welcome dinner at a renowned restaurant, offering an introduction to the country's rich culinary traditions.



DAY 02

Casablanca • Rabat • Fez

Begin the morning exploring Morocco's economic capital.

Visit the elegant Habous Quarter, admire the Royal Palace precinct, Mohammed V Square, the Anfa residential district and the magnificent Hassan II Mosque, one of the largest mosques in the world.

Continue onwards to Rabat, Morocco's royal capital, where you'll discover the Royal Palace (Mechouar), Kasbah of the Oudayas, the Mausoleum of Mohammed V and the iconic Hassan Tower.

Following lunch, continue to the imperial city of Fez.

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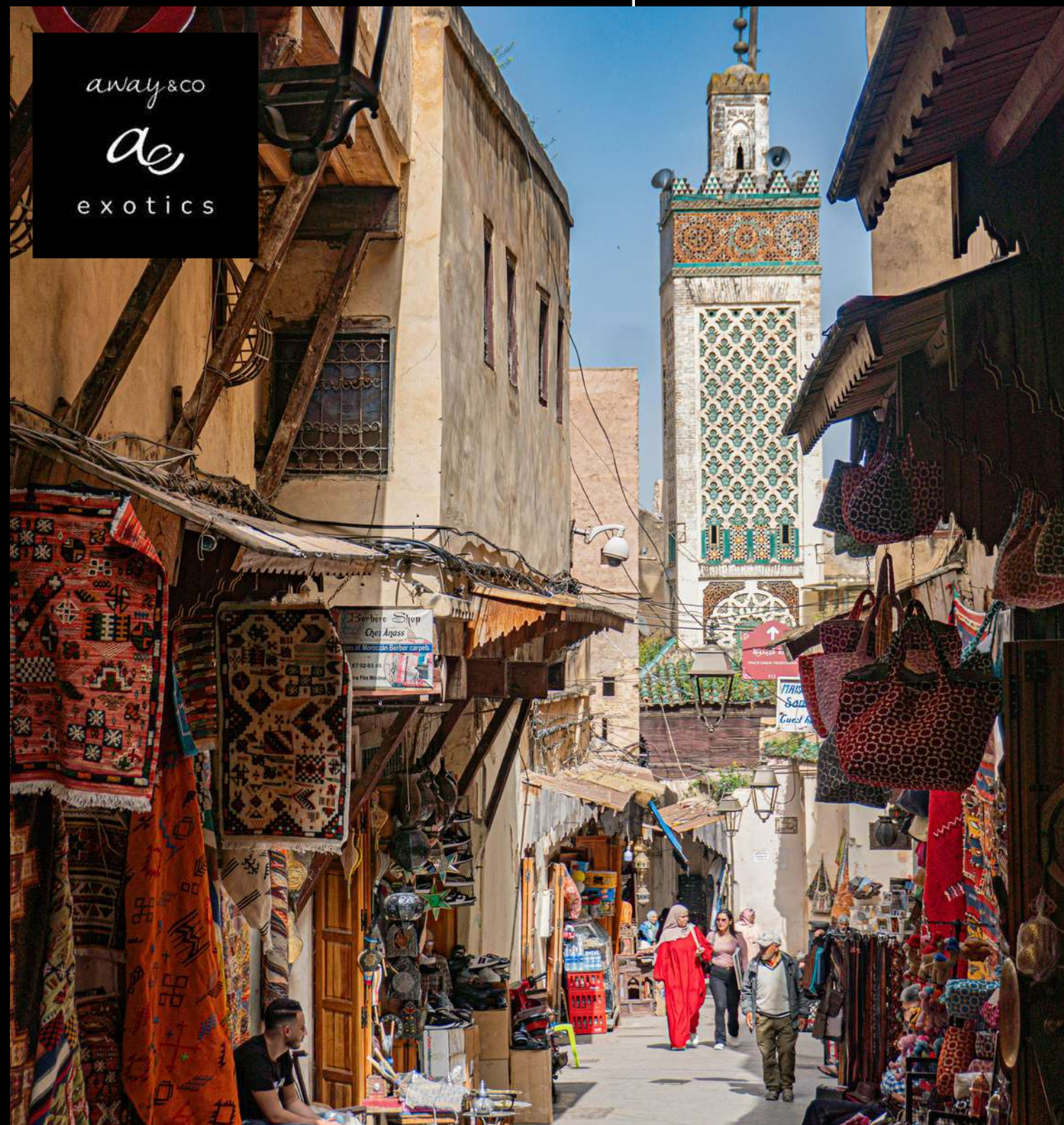
DAY 03

Discover Fez

Spend the day exploring Morocco's spiritual and cultural heart. Walk through the UNESCO-listed Medina, where centuries-old souks, workshops and narrow lanes preserve traditions that have endured for generations.

Visit the magnificent Bou Inania Medersa, admire the ornate Nejjarine Fountain, view the historic Karaouine Mosque and witness the famous leather tanneries, where traditional methods continue much as they have for centuries.

The afternoon introduces you to modern Fez before dinner at an acclaimed restaurant.



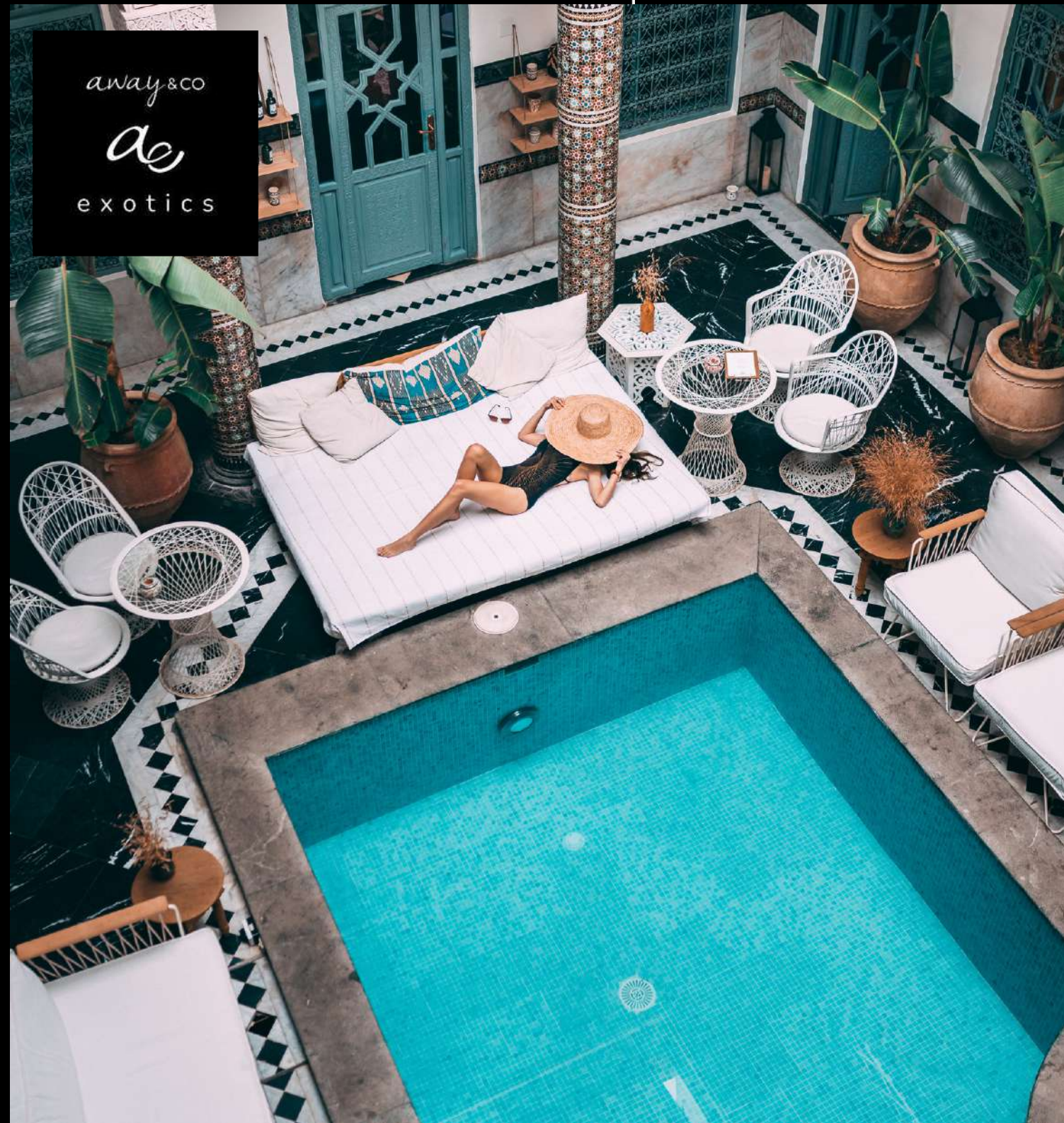
DAY 04

Fez • Beni Mellal • Marrakech

Journey south through changing landscapes, passing the Berber settlements of Immouzer du Kandar and Ifrane before reaching Beni Mellal.

After lunch and a short break, continue towards Marrakech, arriving in the late afternoon.

The evening is yours to relax or enjoy dinner at one of Marrakech's celebrated restaurants.



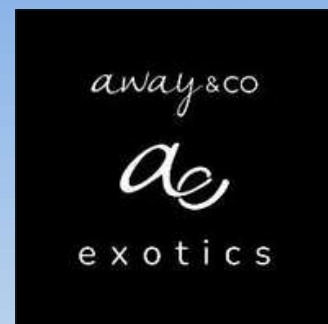
DAY 05

Marrakech

Discover the Pearl of the South. Your morning introduces Marrakech's historic landmarks, including the Menara Gardens, Koutoubia Minaret and the beautifully restored Dar Bacha Museum.

Later, step inside a traditional Moroccan riad for a hands-on cooking class, learning the flavours and techniques that define Moroccan cuisine before enjoying your own creations for lunch.

As evening falls, experience Marrakech from a unique perspective aboard a vintage sidecar, weaving through the medina and stopping to sample local street food.



DAY 06

Atlas Mountains Experience

Travel into the spectacular Atlas Mountains aboard a private 4WD vehicle.

Explore Berber villages, enjoy traditional Moroccan tea with local families and take in the dramatic scenery surrounding the Kik Plateau and Lalla Takerkoust Dam.

Lunch is served at a renowned restaurant before returning to Marrakech.

In the afternoon, visit the enchanting Majorelle Gardens, the Berber Museum and the Yves Saint Laurent Museum.

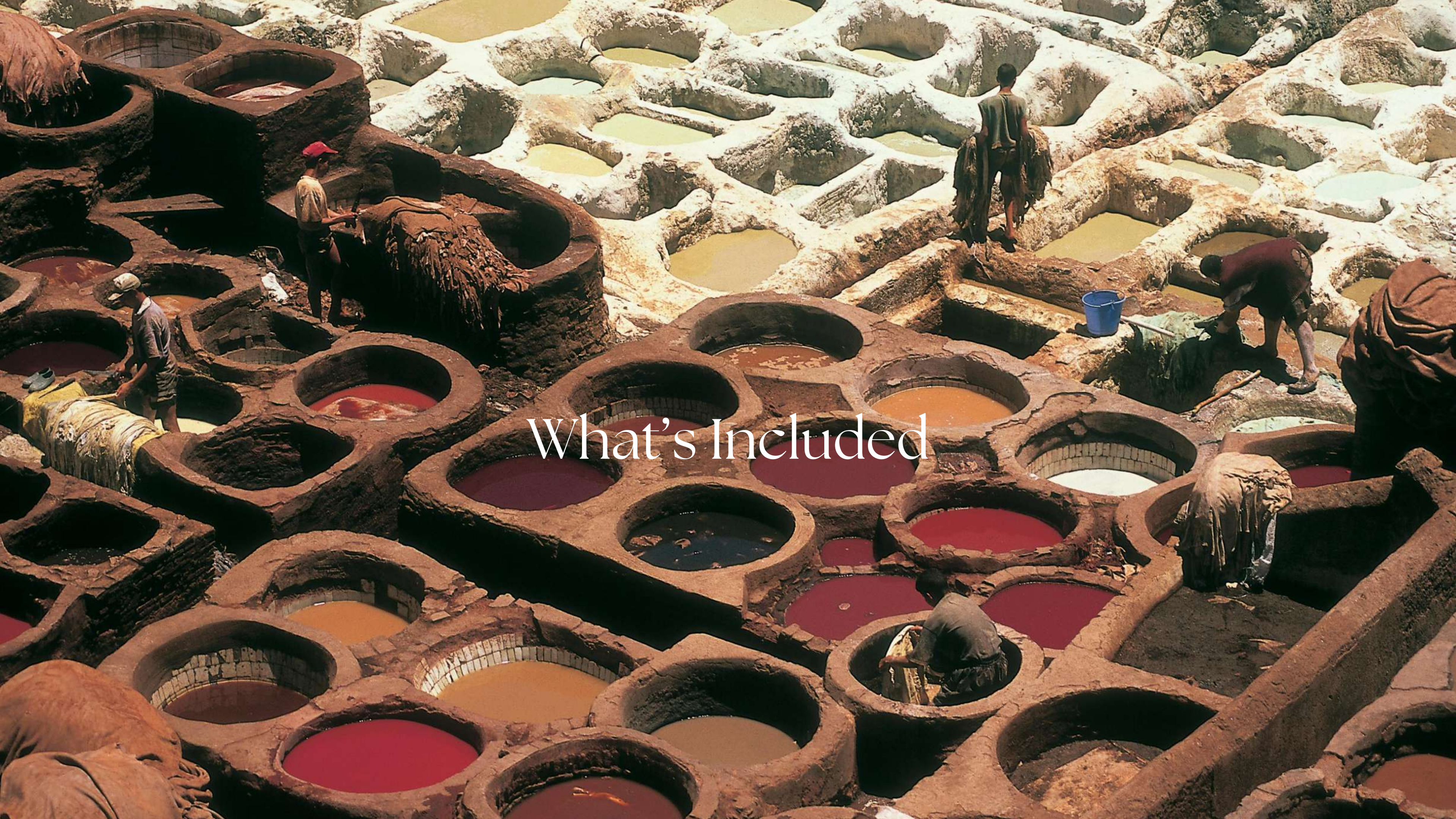
